

TWGT Head selection guide

While so much of the 'what-model-for-what-player' decision lies with a golfer's personal preference and the accurate fitting of the shaft, club length, grip and overall balance, TWGT offers this information for clubmakers who like recommendations as to which of the various player types might be well-suited to the drivers, fairway woods and iron designs in the 2004 TWGT line. *This information is offered to assist clubmakers in making the best possible recommendations to their customers.*

Irons

550C

Players who prefer a smaller classic shape, who like the feel of a soft forging, who hit some off-center iron shots and who prefer less offset.

550M

Players who prefer a smaller classic shape, who like the feel of a soft forging, who hit a minimum of off-center shots, and players who prefer less offset.

702W

Players with slower swing speeds and who need a higher trajectory, and players who like a medium-size head shape.

752TC

All player types, but particularly those who hit some off-center iron shots; players who need a little higher trajectory in the irons, who prefer medium to less offset, but want a more traditional profile shape that is not too large overall in size.

770CFE

All player types, but particularly those who need more iron distance; players who tend to hit the ball off-center more often; players who prefer medium to less offset through the set, and who like a slightly larger overall iron head size.

939H

All player types, but particularly those who want to play long irons but who are not successful with conventional long irons. Also for players who may tend to 'sweep' the ball with irons, or who have a steeper downswing to the ball.

Woods

515GRT

DRIVER – Players who mis-hit the ball low or high on the face, or who hit the ball low and want a higher launch angle. 9.5° loft is for players who already hit the ball average to slightly high or who want a more penetrating flight shape. 11° loft for players who hit the ball average to slightly low and need more launch angle for more carry.

720W

DRIVER – Players with <90mph swing speed, who need higher launch angle for more carry, and who do not wish a very large head size.

FAIRWAY WOOD – Players who hit the ball low with <90mph swing speed and who want more height for more carry.

915CFE

DRIVER – All player types, also good for players who mis-hit the ball horizontally on the face toward heel or toe.

FAIRWAY WOOD – Players who hit the ball med- to high, or who want a med. trajectory, and prefer a slightly larger toe/heel and face to back size.

919CCG

DRIVER – All players, but particularly for those who want higher flight to optimize carry without having to increase loft.

FAIRWAY WOOD – Players who hit the ball med to low, and want more height and prefer a typical fairway head size.
